

## Sample Kokomo, Indiana Itinerary

### Day 1

- 11:45 a.m.** Arrive at **Automotive Heritage Museum**  
1504 N. Reed Rd.; Visitors Bureau: 765-457-6802  
Stretch legs, visit museum containing between 80-100 antique cars and auto-related memorabilia, use restroom, pick up step-on guide
- 12:45 a.m.** Depart for **Sycamore Grille.**
- 1:00 p.m.** Arrive at **Sycamore Grille.** This eclectic restaurant sits on the square in Downtown Kokomo. Sandwiches and pasta are lunch favorites among the fascinating artwork and antique pieces.
- 2:15 p.m.** Depart for **Elwood Haynes Museum**  
1915 S. Webster, Kokomo
- 2:30 p.m.** Tour **Elwood Haynes Museum**  
Haynes invented America's first car, stainless steel and an alloy called stellite, the strongest metal known to man. Artifacts from Haynes' personal and business life are housed in his former home.
- 3:15 p.m.** Depart for drive through **Highland Park**  
Stop to see **Old Ben**, the World's Largest Steer, the enormous **Sycamore Stump** and the **Vermont Covered Bridge.**
- 3:45 p.m.** Depart for hotel
- 4:00 p.m.** Check into hotel
- 6:30 p.m.** Gather in the lobby & begin boarding the coach
- 6:45 p.m.** Travel to the **Seiberling Mansion**  
1200 W. Sycamore Street, Kokomo
- 7:00 p.m.** Be a guest at the biggest event of 1893. Witness the **Wedding of Emma Seiberling**, eldest daughter in Kokomo's most prominent family, at the late Victorian-style mansion. Feast on the Victorian fare for dinner and enjoy a toast presented by the best man. Later, take a tour of the mansion, stroll across the grounds or join in on a sing-along in the music room.
- 9:00 p.m.** Return to hotel

## Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel

**8:15 a.m.** Depart for **Kokomo Opalescent Glass Co.**  
1310 S. Market St.

**8:30 a.m.** Tour **Kokomo Opalescent Glass Factory**, shop in Op Shop retail store.  
The Kokomo Opalescent Glass Factory Co. has made stained glass since 1888. On the tour, get close enough to feel the heat as the molten glass is dripped across the floor as the ladles are carried to the mixing table. A newer addition to the tour is the Hot Glass Studio, where artists create blown glass objects.

**9:30 a.m.** Depart for Greentown

**10:00 a.m.** Tour **Greentown Glass Museum, Greentown Historical Museum, Mast Furniture** and **Greentown Antique Mall.**

**11:00 a.m.** Depart for **Grissom Air Museum**

**11:30 a.m.** Tour **Grissom Air Museum & Outdoor Air Park.**  
See vintage fighter planes and military exhibits dating back to WWI.

**12:45 p.m.** Lunch at **The Siding** in Peru  
Enjoy a great buffet in a converted train car.

**2:00 p.m.** Tour **Circus Museum & Circus City Festival**  
After viewing hundreds of circus memorabilia in the Circus Museum, experience Circus performers practicing or performing on high wires and flying trapeae.

**3:00 p.m.** Tour **Miami County Museum**  
One of the largest count museums in Indiana, the museum includes a large collection of items from the Miami tribe and articles once belonging to composer and songwriter Cole Porter who was born and raised in Peru.

**4:30 p.m.** Relax at the hotel

**6:15 p.m.** Dinner at **Pastariffic**  
Locally owned Italian Restaurant serves up their own extraordinary dishes made in their own kitchen.

**8:00 p.m.** Enjoy **Kokomo Park Band Concert**  
Every Wednesday evening, in he summer, the Kokomo Park Band performs at the stage in Highland Park. Reminiscent of long-ago times, concertgoers bring lawn chairs or sit on part benches to hear this professional group perform for **free.**
